

# *Entering the Room*

## Galatians Series – Part 3

Scripture text – Galatians 2:1-10

### Introduction

- Think of every Bible passage as a \_\_\_\_\_ into which, on Sunday morning, we are invited to investigate and live in.

### Part 1: The Theme of the Room

- The theme of this passage (“room”) is the \_\_\_\_\_ of the gospel. There is but \_\_\_\_\_ gospel and it is \_\_\_\_\_.

### Part 2: Touring the Room

### Part 3: Living in the Room

- It comes down to a simple question: Do you want to be \_\_\_\_\_, or do you want to be a \_\_\_\_\_?
